## EYE SAFETY!

Over 90% of all eye injuries can be prevented by following established safety guidelines. Use the appropriate protective eyewear for the tasks you perform and learn to recognize the most common eye hazards.

### PROTECT YOUR EYES!

- Common hazards include flying particles, dusts, sparks, fumes, and splashes
- Be alert to the hazards present at your worksite
- Wear appropriate protective eyewear identified for your assignment and remember, regular eyeglasses or contact lenses will not protect you from eye hazards
- Make sure your protective eyewear fits properly and is clean and in good condition before and after each use
- Replace faulty eyewear immediately
- Follow established safety guidelines
- Learn the basics of first-aid for eye injuries
- Know where all eyewash stations and emergency equipment are located
- In the event of an eye injury get medical attention immediately
